

Presentation

- Decide your topic as soon as possible, and look for articles or books about it. Any topic is fine, but you need to be interested in the topic. Choose a debatable topic. Consult me to choose a topic.
- Once you choose a topic, research it. Look for as many articles and references as possible. Particularly, you need to know backgrounds of the topic.
- Select one article about which you will talk. This article should be about 2 to 4 pages long. Submit the article to me by a previous class to your presentation.
- Your presentation will be 15 minutes long. You will talk for about 10 minutes, and answer questions for 5 minutes. All group members should talk during the presentation.
- During your presentation, you need to explain the background of the topic (including what kind of problems there are) and to summarize what was written in the article.
- After your presentation, you need to answer questions from the class.
- For your presentation, I would recommend to use some visual aids, such as a handout, the overhead, or the projector, etc.
